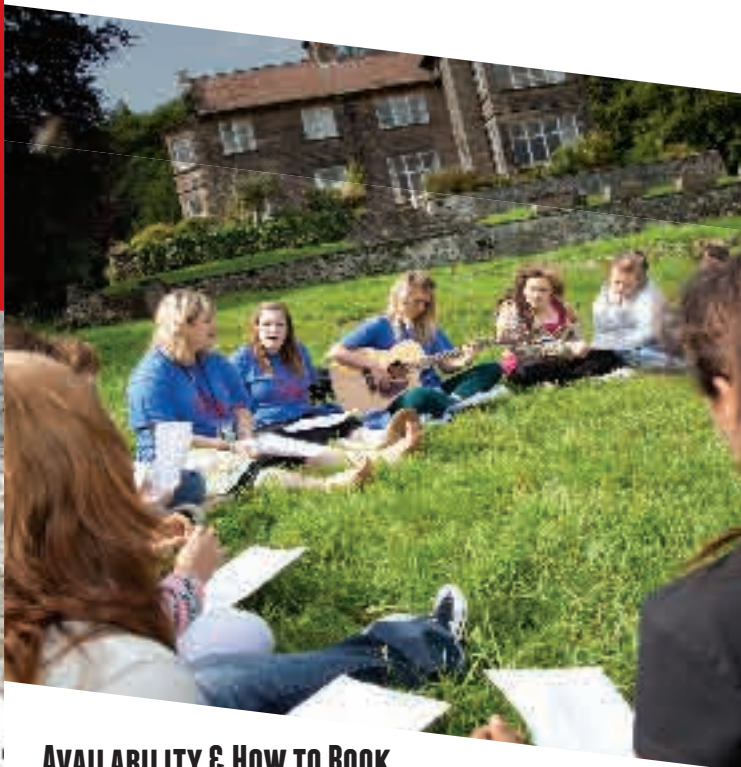

breaks for kids

Breaks for Kids is a charitable fund, founded and supported by our partners at YHA. The fund provides financial support to disadvantaged children to enable them to join their classmates on a residential school trip. The fund can contribute up to 50% of the cost of accommodation & food elements and applications are considered on the basis of the number of children in the group who are entitled to free school meals or whose parents are in receipt of income support or housing benefit*

OUR PROGRAMMES:

CASTLETON:

Invaders & Settlers: The group become time detectives and build up a time line of Castleton settlers from prehistoric times to the present day through a series of activities and role-play. They learn to fire a longbow, take part in an archaeological dig, build a Roman siege engine, solve a Saxon Rune Puzzle, storm a Norman Castle, defend a Celtic fortress or are conscripted into the Roman army by a Centurion.

A Contrasting Locality: The group investigate the village - who lives there and why. Through survey work and exploration of the village and the surrounding area the group discover the link between the landscape, the geology and the growth of the settlement as a contrasting UK locality. The activities include panning for local minerals, a trip underground, role-play, fossil hunting and a search for an earthquake.

P.E. Teambuilding Adventure: The group take on a variety of challenges to develop their team working skills. **Activities include Longbow Archery, Swamp crossing, Bridge building, Spider's web and GPS trails.**

ILAM HALL:

P.E. Teambuilding Adventure: A hugely popular programme delivered in great surroundings by an all team. This action packed programme guides the group through a series of challenges closely linked to PLTS themes. **Activities include: GPS trails, Long Bow Archery, Shelter Building, Camp Craft, Circus Skills and a range of team building activities.**

RAVENSTOR:

Drama & Performing Arts: A wonderful programme geared towards Key Stage 2 & 3. Activities are designed to build teamwork skills and individual self-confidence, as well as providing a platform for the group to experience new skills in a range of creative art forms. Upon completion of their stay all participants receive attendance certificates to acknowledge their time with us. **Activities include: Acting workshops, Pantomime, Musical Theatre, Dance & Singing, Comedy & Characterisation, Costume Design, Invisible Theatre, Rehearsal Workshop, Film Workshop, Ravenstor's Got Talent (contest).**

All trips run lunchtime to lunchtime and include: 2 x half day & 1 x full day of activities plus 2 evening sessions.

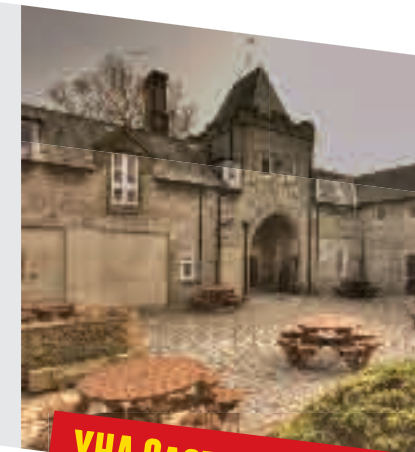

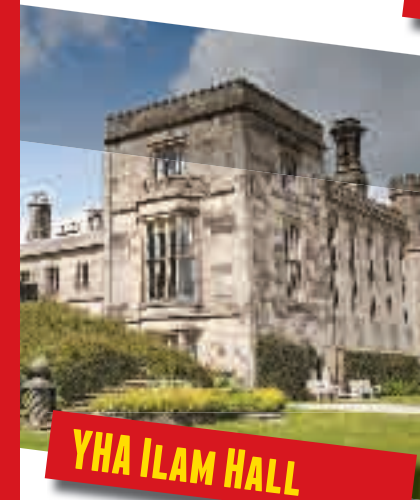


YHA CASTLETON
